1 WHEREAS, Many young men and women from the Lone Star State
2 volunteered their service during the course of World War II, and it
3 was the willingness of these fine citizens to make any sacrifice
4 necessary for the cause of liberty that enabled our country to
5 survive with the many freedoms we cherish today still intact; and

6 WHEREAS, This year marks the 60th anniversary of the
7 conclusion of this momentous conflict, and the victory that was so
8 dearly bought by the members of our armed services and other Allied
9 forces remains to many the single most significant event of the 20th
10 century; and

11 WHEREAS, On April 3, 2005, a ceremony was held by the City of
12 San Antonio and the U.S. Department of Defense to honor those whose
13 courageous efforts helped to secure final victory for their nation;

15 WHEREAS, History has shown repeatedly that our democracy is
16 only as strong as those valiant individuals on whom we rely to
17 protect it; the sacrifices of the men and women who served in World
18 War II remain undiminished by the passage of time, and it is fitting
19 that they be honored as we commemorate the 60th anniversary of the
20 conclusion of World War II; now, therefore, be it

21 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas
22 Legislature hereby pay homage to the brave U.S. soldiers who
23 defended this nation during World War II.
