2 loving moments may comfort the family and friends of Frankie Reid  
3 Neal Moore, who passed away on April 19, 2005, at the age of 94; and

4           WHEREAS, A longtime resident of Houston, Mrs. Moore was born  
5 in Newnan, Georgia, on August 31, 1910, and earned her bachelor's  
6 degree from Clark College in Atlanta and her master's degree in  
7 guidance and counseling from Texas Southern University; this  
8 dynamic woman enjoyed an outstanding career as a science teacher  
9 and guidance counselor for Houston ISD, enhancing the lives of  
10 innumerable young Texans through the years; and

11           WHEREAS, Mrs. Moore was a highly regarded member of her  
12 community and gave of her time and talents to a host of  
13 organizations, including Delta Sigma Theta Sorority, the National  
14 Education Association, and the Girl Scouts of America, who honored  
15 her with the Girl Scout Thanks Badge, the highest award for  
16 volunteer service in scouting; moreover, she was a woman of deep  
17 faith and a member of Pilgrim Congregational United Church of  
18 Christ in Houston, the church her husband, Pastor John D. Moore, led  
19 before his death, and an associate member of Church of the Apostles  
20 United Church of Christ in Lancaster; and

21           WHEREAS, Devoted to her family, Mrs. Moore made a loving home  
22 for her husband, and her two daughters, Karna and E. Dametta, and  
23 she also set an inspiring example for others in her role as a  
24 pastor's wife; and

1           WHEREAS, Those fortunate enough to have known Frankie Moore  
2 will long remember her for her many endearing qualities, and  
3 although she will be greatly missed, her legacy will live on in the  
4 hearts of all the people whose lives she touched; now, therefore, be
