14 was one of meritorious service, loyalty, personal bravery, and  
15 self-sacrifice consistent with the high ideals of the law

17           WHEREAS, Killed in the line of duty on September 21, 2004, his  
18 untimely death was a tragic loss to his family, to his fellow peace  
19 officers, and to the entire community; and

22 follow in a difficult but essential profession; now, therefore, be

2 Agent Travis W. Attaway of the United States Border Patrol and
