WHEREAS, Every day, more than 150 Texans die from
cardiovascular disease and stroke; and

3 WHEREAS, High blood pressure and elevated cholesterol levels are the primary risk factors for coronary heart disease, which is 4 5 the nation's single leading cause of death; according to the 6 American Heart Association, an estimated 100 million Americans have total blood cholesterol values of 200 mg/dl and higher, and nearly 7 40 million American adults have values of 240 or above, levels that 8 9 constitute a major risk factor for coronary heart disease and 10 stroke; and
