R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Those peace officers who lose their lives in the
2 line of duty are truly deserving of the gratitude of every Texan,
3 and it is with heavy hearts and a deep sense of indebtedness that we
4 pay tribute to the memory of Senior Patrol Agent Jeremy Wilson of
5 the United States Border Patrol, who perished in the waters of the
6 Rio Grande on September 19, 2004, at the age of 29; and

7 WHEREAS, Agent Wilson and two fellow officers were conducting
8 a patrol near Los Indios on that date when their craft capsized in
9 turbulent water; and

10 WHEREAS, Although a nearby patrol boat responded to the
11 distress signal quickly enough to save one of the officers, Agent
12 Wilson and another agent were lost in the rain-swollen river; and

13 WHEREAS, The possibility of such sudden and shocking loss of
14 life is the constant companion of the nation's peace officers, who
15 willingly and routinely face danger in behalf of their fellow
16 citizens, and Agent Wilson's sacrifice is a sobering reminder of
17 this dedication; now, therefore, be it

18 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas
19 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Senior Patrol Agent
20 Jeremy Wilson of the United States Border Patrol and extend sincere
21 sympathy to his family and friends; and, be it further

22 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
23 prepared for the members of his family and that when the Texas House
24 of Representatives adjourns this day, it do so in memory of Senior
