1           WHEREAS, Citizens of the Lone Star State benefit each day  
2 from the efforts of government workers who have devoted their  
3 careers to protecting public safety and health, maintaining  
4 utilities and infrastructure, preserving the rule of law under a  
5 fair judicial system, safeguarding natural resources for future  
6 generations, and creating economic opportunities for Texans of all  
7 ages and backgrounds; and

8           WHEREAS, Public employees include teachers to educate our  
9 children, nurses to administer vaccines, computer technicians to  
10 pay our benefits, safety inspectors to guarantee the safety of our  
11 workplaces, food inspectors to guarantee the safety of our grocery  
12 purchases, laborers to maintain our roads and bridges, and  
13 transportation employees to see us safely to our destinations; and

14           WHEREAS, Many public employees, such as police officers,  
15 firefighters, border patrol officers, embassy employees, military  
16 personnel, and health care professionals, frequently place their  
17 own lives in jeopardy in order to protect ours; and

18           WHEREAS, Since 1985, Public Service Recognition Week has been  
19 celebrated across the nation during the first week in May, offering  
20 an opportunity to inform Americans about the broad variety of  
21 services provided by government and to promote awareness of the  
22 innumerable ways, both direct and indirect, in which government  
23 services touch and improve the quality of our lives every day; now,
