2 meaningful accomplishments may help to comfort the family and
3 friends of Jose Maria Zambrano of El Paso, who passed away on April
4 2, 2005, at the age of 80; and

5 WHEREAS, Born in San Elizario on May 28, 1924, Mr. Zambrano
6 answered his country's call to arms as a young man during World War
7 II and received a Purple Heart for his meritorious service in the
8 Pacific theater as a member of the U.S. Army; and

9 WHEREAS, Following his return to civilian life, he moved to
10 Los Angeles, California, where he embarked on a career path that
11 would see this self-made man retire from K-B Axle 45 years later in
12 the post of executive sales manager of the company; and

13 WHEREAS, A founding member of St. Francis Xavier Church in
14 Burbank, California, as well as a member of the Knights of Columbus,
15 Mr. Zambrano continued his community involvement following his
16 return to Texas with his wife, Soledad, in retirement; remaining
17 active in his service to the church, he was an usher at St.
18 Stephen's Church, and he was also a founding member of the San
19 Elizario Genealogy Society; and

20 WHEREAS, During his lifetime, Jose Zambrano was a devoted
21 family man and friend whose caring ways benefited not only his loved
22 ones but also the wider community, and he will long be missed; now,
23 therefore, be it
