1 WHEREAS, Those Texans who act quickly and appropriately in
2 emergencies are truly deserving of our admiration and gratitude,
3 and Selena Renee Solis of El Paso is one such individual; and

4 WHEREAS, This resourceful five-year-old's courage became
5 apparent when her mother suffered a seizure and lost consciousness
6 while driving Selena and her two-week-old brother on Transmountain
7 Road; and

8 WHEREAS, Bereft of a driver, the car veered off the road,
9 jumping the curb and crashing through two yards before colliding
10 with a rock wall; and

11 WHEREAS, Realizing that her only escape from the car was
12 through the window, Selena crawled to safety and ran to a nearby
13 home to get help, and her rapid response ensured that her mother and
14 brother received immediate medical attention, averting a terrible
15 tragedy that could have claimed both of their lives; and

16 WHEREAS, In acting as she did, Selena Solis distinguished
17 herself as a remarkable member of the community and earned
18 recognition from the El Paso Area Chapter of the American Red Cross;
19 now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas
21 Legislature hereby honor Selena Renee Solis for her heroism and
22 extend to her sincere best wishes for the future; and, be it further
