5 WHEREAS, On September 30, 2004, Mr. Hernandez, a school 6 resource officer at Bel Air High School, noticed a car angled 7 awkwardly by the school and soon determined that the driver inside 8 was unconscious and had no vital signs; and

WHEREAS, Placing the car in park, he removed the individual from the vehicle, radioed for help, and performed cardiopulmonary resuscitation on the driver; he was soon joined by Mr. Martinez, who assisted him in performing CPR until emergency medical personnel arrived at the scene; moreover, Mr. Martinez worked to ensure the safety of students present on the scene as well as to minimize their trauma; and
