17 Society, and Drs. Garza and Ramirez have also acted as president of
18 the Texas Association of Family Practice; and

20 depend on medical professionals like Drs. Trevino, Garza, and
21 Ramirez, who treat their patients with compassion and wisdom; it is
22 a privilege to join the citizens of Hidalgo and Starr Counties in
