2 of Hermes Villarreal of San Juan on April 19, 2005, at the age of 41;

4 WHEREAS, A native of McAllen, where he was born on August 2,
5 1963, he was a graduate of Edinburg High School who went on to earn a
6 bachelor of business administration degree in finance from Pan
7 American University and a doctor of jurisprudence degree from The
8 University of Texas School of Law; he returned to the Valley to open
9 his law practice, and during his notable career he was highly
10 regarded for the integrity and compassion he demonstrated in behalf
11 of his clients and the greater community; and

12 WHEREAS, Mr. Villarreal's volunteerism benefited a multitude
13 of people; his service with the Hidalgo County Head Start Policy
14 Council was truly a case of giving back, for he was enrolled in the
15 program himself as a child; appointed to the Tropical Texas Center
16 for MHMR in 2002, he was later elected board chair and played a key
17 role in the organization's success over the past several years; his
18 community involvement also encompassed board membership with the
19 Boys and Girls Club of Pharr and terms as worshipful master of
20 McAllen Masonic Lodge No. 1110 and District Deputy Grand Master of
21 the Grand Lodge of Texas; and

22 WHEREAS, Devoted to his wife, Diana, and their children,
23 Sarah, Lauren, and Hermes, Hermes Villarreal gave generously of
24 himself to benefit others in myriad ways; a talented artist whose

1 beautiful paintings and drawings lend insight into his appreciation
2 and love of life, he will long be fondly remembered by all who were
3 privileged to know him; now, therefore, be it
