11 Klein Middle School in Houston; and

13 District in 1986 as an English teacher at Crowley High School, a
14 position she held for nine years until becoming an instructional
15 principal; after four years, she was made principal of Crowley
16 Ninth Grade Center; and

18 educator and administrator, Mrs. Franek played a positive role in
19 the lives of countless people, and she is deeply missed; now,
