1 WHEREAS, Austin College in Sherman observed a very special
2 event in the history of the institution in March 2005 with the
3 establishment of the Austin College Leadership Award; and

4 WHEREAS, A tangible example of the institution's commitment
5 to leadership, this prestigious accolade is designed to acknowledge
6 outstanding individuals who have applied their leadership talents
7 to make a positive impact on society locally, nationally, or
8 internationally; and

9 WHEREAS, Honorees will demonstrate the values inherent in the
10 college, which are responsibility, respect, caring, gratitude, and
11 service; moreover, recipients will exemplify the principles of
12 servant leadership by taking a courageous stand on a public policy
13 issue that advances a humanitarian or educational purpose, serving
14 the youth of a community to improve the quality of health,
15 educational, or community services, or creating opportunities for
16 young people that help them enhance their educational experience
17 and move to a new level of service to society; and

18 WHEREAS, The first recipient of the leadership award will be
19 announced in March 2006; in addition to receiving a cash prize of
20 \$100,000, the individual will visit the Austin College campus to
21 speak to community leaders and interact with students and faculty;

23 WHEREAS, The Austin College Leadership Award will honor those
24 who show through their actions an abiding commitment to creating a

1 brighter future for their fellow citizens, and this notable aim is
2 truly deserving of acknowledgment; now, therefore, be it

3 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas
4 Legislature hereby commemorate the establishment of the Austin
5 College Leadership Award and commend all those who have worked to
6 bring this significant endeavor to fruition; and, be it further

7 RESOLVED, That an official copy of this resolution be
