6 moved in her early teens to Glen Rose, where she was named
7 valedictorian of her high school class and selected to represent
8 her community as Miss Glen Rose in the Miss Texas Pageant of 1929;

11 Lutheran College, which she attended on a scholarship, and she went
12 on to marry Hattley C. Tindall, with whom she enjoyed a very happy
13 marriage until his death in 1995; and

15 Mrs. Tindall spent her last years in Friendswood, where she pursued
16 her lifelong interests in literature and flowers and took special
17 pleasure in spending time with her loved ones; and

18 WHEREAS, Mrs. Tindall was also a valued member of Oso Chapter
19 No. 868 of the Order of the Eastern Star and the Daughters of the
20 Confederacy, and her presence will be missed by her friends in those
21 organizations; and

23 admirers may take comfort in the fact that hers was a life well
24 lived and rich with unique experiences; now, therefore, be it
