WHEREAS, This respected businessman also made significant contributions to his community through his service as president of the Weslaco Kiwanis Club and board member of the Weslaco Chamber of Commerce and McAllen's Temple Emanuel; he was especially proud of his work in the Rotary Club of Weslaco, which he served as president for the 1995-1996 Rotary year and as the district governor's representative from 1997-1998, in addition to having 15 years of
