1 WHEREAS, Reyes Torres Garcia, Jr., of Houston has made an
2 indelible impact on his neighborhood as a community leader and
3 organizer; and

4 WHEREAS, A native of Taft, Mr. Garcia served in the military
5 and in 1968 moved to Houston; he settled in North Houston, where he
6 purchased a home in the High Meadows North subdivision and became
7 actively involved with community organizations; and

8 WHEREAS, This notable Texan is a member of St. Leo the Great
9 Catholic Church and a founding member of the High Meadows North
10 Civic Club, which he has served as president since 1990; he has
11 further demonstrated his devotion to the High Meadows North area by
12 joining local business leaders in a grassroots campaign to save the
13 neighborhood from decline; those efforts resulted in the creation
14 of the Aldine Community District, and Mr. Garcia continues to serve
15 on the district board; and

16 WHEREAS, The strength and vitality of our communities depend
17 on the tireless dedication of individuals like Reyes Garcia, who
18 has earned the respect and admiration of his neighbors for his
19 commitment to the continued betterment of their neighborhood; now,

22 Legislature hereby honor Reyes Torres Garcia, Jr., for his
23 exceptional service to his community and extend to him sincere best
