17 WHEREAS, Ms. Weisberg-Stewart served on the board of the 18 First McAllen Development Corporation during a number of major 19 construction projects; she is on the Heart of the City board and the 20 board of Future McAllen and is in her second year as chair of the 21 McAllen Chamber of Commerce; she is also involved in the U.S. Visit 22 Program that is working to allow Mexicans the same visiting rights 23 as Canadians; and
