14 de Mayo Solidarity March and the cofounder of the Northwest
15 Coalition Against Malicious Harassment; in addition, he is a member

18 Willacy and Cameron Counties; and

20 inspiration and encouragement from his wife, Anita Trevino Candia;
21 his exemplary efforts in support of those in need have earned him
22 the respect and admiration of countless individuals, and it is a
