1 WHEREAS, Memories of meaningful accomplishments and joyful
2 moments may comfort the family and friends of Gunther H. Moller, who
3 passed away on May 2, 2005, at the age of 80; and

4 WHEREAS, Professor emeritus of Sul Ross State University, Dr.
5 Moller received his doctoral degree in mathematics from the
6 University of Hamburg in Germany in 1955; his family emigrated to
7 the United States in 1957, and he held teaching positions at
8 Kalamazoo College and Texas Lutheran College before joining the
9 faculty of SRSU in 1962; and

10 WHEREAS, This esteemed scholar was a past member of the
11 Mathematical Association of America, the National Council of
12 Teachers of Mathematics, the Royal Astronomical Society of Canada,
13 and the Southwest Regional Conference for Astronomy and
14 Astrophysics; after his retirement from the university in 1991, he
15 continued to publish articles in various astrophysics journals; and

16 WHEREAS, A self-proclaimed "native" Texan, Dr. Moller loved
17 the Big Bend region of his adopted state, and he will be remembered
18 by those who knew him as a challenging professor and a loving
19 husband and father; now, therefore, be it

20 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas
21 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Gunther H. Moller and
22 extend deepest sympathy to the members of his family: to his wife,
23 Waltraut Erika "Trudy" Moller; to his sons, Jerry Moeller and
