R E S O L U T I O N

21 International Bible Institute, and obtained a master's degree in
22 Christian counseling psychology; and

24 in the Texas communities of Happy and Shamrock, as well as in

1 Portales, New Mexico; he has worked as a missionary in Ukraine,
2 teaching students at the Ukrainian Bible Institute, and is
3 currently an associate minister at College Hill Church of Christ in
4 North Richland Hills; in addition, he has coached basketball,
5 soccer, and baseball, and enjoys teaching and coaching softball at
6 Fort Worth Christian High School; and
