R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, Dr. Mary Chua Jeu of Houston is retiring from her
2 position as chief of Park Plaza Anesthesiologists in May 2005,
3 bringing to a close an exceptional career in the medical profession
4 that has spanned more than four decades; and

5 WHEREAS, A native of Quezon City in the Philippines, Dr. Jeu
6 earned her medical doctor degree from the University of Santo
7 Thomas in her country's capital city of Manila; and

8 WHEREAS, This notable woman began work in the United States
9 in 1964, serving as a medical intern at Houston's Memorial and M. D.
10 Anderson Hospitals; she then completed a residency at Cornell New
11 York Hospital before returning to M. D. Anderson to complete her
12 residency and fellowship; and

13 WHEREAS, By 1970, she was asked to join the hospital's staff
14 and served M. D. Anderson until 1975 when she accepted a position at
15 Methodist Hospital; three years later, she left to become a partner
16 at Park Plaza Anesthesiologists and was named its chief in 1988; and

17 WHEREAS, Dr. Jeu has further distinguished herself through
18 her involvement in a host of professional and civic organizations,
19 including the American College of Anesthesiology, American Board of
20 Anesthesiology, and the Texas Board of Medical Examiners; moreover,
21 she has given of her time and talents to the Harris County Medical
22 Society, Houston Academy of Medicine, and the Chinese Baptist
23 Church; and

24 WHEREAS, Dr. Jeu has set a sterling example of

1 professionalism to which all may aspire, and while her presence
2 will be greatly missed by her colleagues, the myriad
3 accomplishments of her tenure will not soon be forgotten; now,
4 therefore, be it

5 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas
6 Legislature hereby congratulate Dr. Mary Chua Jeu on the occasion
7 of her retirement as chief of Park Plaza Anesthesiologists and
8 extend to her sincere best wishes for the future; and, be it further
