1 WHEREAS, The Reverend Daryl R. Carter of Carver Heights
2 Baptist Church in Dallas is celebrating his first pastoral
3 anniversary at the church, and this occasion offers a fitting
4 opportunity to recognize this esteemed gentleman; and

5 WHEREAS, A Dallas native, Reverend Carter graduated from
6 South Oak Cliff High School in 1977 before serving in the U.S. Army
7 as a radio communications repairman; continuing his education
8 following his military service, he received an associate's degree
9 in applied arts and science from Mountain View College in 1985; and

10 WHEREAS, Today, Reverend Carter holds a bachelor's degree in
11 theology from the Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in Fort
12 Worth, and he is currently pursuing a master's degree in divinity;
13 long affiliated with the church he now leads, he has been an active
14 member of Carver Heights Baptist Church for a number of years and
15 was ordained as a deacon in 1996; and

16 WHEREAS, A talented businessman as well as a man of great
17 faith, Reverend Carter has excelled in several independent business
18 ventures; in all his endeavors, he demonstrates strength of
19 character and generosity of spirit, and he has earned a
20 well-deserved reputation as a role model for young and old alike;

22 WHEREAS, Reverend Carter delivered his first sermon at Carver
23 Heights in March 1997; just two years later, he was named assistant
24 to the pastor, a position he embraced until his election as

1 co-pastor in June 2002; he assumed the pastorship shortly
2 thereafter, when his father, the late Reverend Tyler Carter,
3 stepped down from his duties due to poor health; and

4 WHEREAS, Together with his wife, Brenda, the Reverend Daryl
5 Carter has gained the respect and admiration of a devoted
6 congregation; his tenure as pastor has been a blessing to these
7 faithful souls, who look forward with anticipation to his continued
8 leadership of the congregation; now, therefore, be it

10 Legislature hereby congratulate the Reverend Daryl Carter on the
11 occasion of his first anniversary as pastor of Carver Heights
