2 anniversary of its founding in 2005; and

3           WHEREAS, The post office has served as a vital link of  
4 communication between the city's residents and friends,  
5 businesses, relatives, and governmental bodies around the world;

7           WHEREAS, William R. McMillan, one of the founders of  
8 Winnsboro, was appointed the first postmaster on March 6, 1855;  
9 today, postmaster Ronny Shirley, the 22nd individual to hold the  
10 position, oversees 5,500 delivery addresses and more than 10  
11 million pieces of mail annually; and

12           WHEREAS, Many generations of Winnsboro residents have  
13 enjoyed the dependable and friendly service of the employees of the  
14 Winnsboro Post Office, and it is appropriate to take this  
15 opportunity to recognize them on this special occasion; now,
