## RESOLUTION

1 WHEREAS, The Texas House of Representatives takes pride in 2 paying tribute to the memory of Staff Sergeant Jimmie Doyle of the 3 U.S. Army Air Corps, who gave his life in service to this nation 4 during World War II; and

5 WHEREAS, A loving husband to his wife, Myrle, and father to 6 his son, Tommy, Sergeant Doyle left his home in Lamesa to join the 7 armed forces, answering his country's call to arms as a member of 8 the 307th bomber group of the U.S. Army's 13th Air Corps; and

9 WHEREAS, Tragically, while serving as a tail gunner aboard a 10 B-24 Liberator, this courageous Texan was shot down over the 11 Pacific on September 1, 1944, adding to the heavy toll of 12 heartbreaking loss endured by so many American families during the 13 course of the war; and

14 WHEREAS, Sergeant Doyle's status remained classified as 15 missing in action, as his family struggled to carry on without the 16 beloved husband and father; six decades had passed when, in 2004, 17 the wreckage of his plane was discovered off the coast of Palau, 18 thanks to the diligent efforts of volunteers from the Bent Prop 19 Project; and

20 WHEREAS, The generation of Americans that fought during World 21 War II preserved their nation's freedom for decades to come, and 22 Sergeant Doyle is an inspirational example of the bravery and 23 dedication to duty that were required to assure victory in that 24 conflict; now, therefore, be it
