WHEREAS, Dr. Runnels established the Youth Citizenship Seminar in 1977 whereby approximately 250 high school junior students from throughout California participate in a program on the Pepperdine University campus to interact with leaders such as George Foreman, Art Linkletter, Tommy Lasorda, Tom Selleck, leading public officials, and various citizen heroes to discuss good citizenship, free enterprise, freedom, and faith; and
