15 Morocco; in 1967, she moved with her husband to Dallas and worked as
16 a tour director for student trips to Europe and the Middle East; and

17 WHEREAS, Today, the devoted couple live in San Antonio and
18 enjoy a close relationship with their three children, eight
19 grandchildren, and seven great-grandchildren; and

20 WHEREAS, From riding her favorite stallion, Diamond, into
21 Blanco as a girl to directing tours to exotic locales as an adult,
22 Jean Dale Manes has more than eight decades of wonderful memories to
23 cherish, and she continues to brighten the lives of all who know
24 her; now, therefore, be it
