

R E S O L U T I O N

1 WHEREAS, A loving family and good friends are deeply saddened
2 by the death of Canuto Garcia, Jr., of Edinburg, who passed away on
3 May 6, 2005, at the age of 79; and

4 WHEREAS, Born in Falfurrias, Mr. Garcia served with valor in
5 the United States Army Air Force during World War II; a bottom
6 turret gunner in a B-17 Flying Fortress of the 447th Bomber Group in
7 England, he was twice shot down over Germany; he was captured in
8 April 1945 by the Germans, declared missing in action, and was a
9 prisoner of war until he was liberated in May 1945; for his
10 distinguished service, he received the Purple Heart, Air Medal,
11 European Theatre of Operations Ribbon with two Battle Stars, and
12 the Good Conduct Medal; and

13 WHEREAS, After returning home, Mr. Garcia married his high
14 school sweetheart, Elida Benavidez, and worked as a private pilot
15 and attended Edinburg Junior College; he was a banker for 20 years
16 and became a partner with the Garcia Longoria Cattle Company and the
17 owner/operator of Pan American Transportation, a nationwide
18 transportation company; and

19 WHEREAS, This esteemed gentleman, who loved hunting and
20 ranching, was a devoted husband and family man and cherished friend
21 to many, and he will not soon be forgotten; and

22 WHEREAS, Representative Aaron Pena has honored the life of
23 Canuto Garcia, Jr., by passing this resolution in his memory during
24 the 79th Texas Legislative Session; now, therefore, be it

1 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas
2 Legislature hereby pay tribute to the life of Canuto Garcia, Jr.,
3 and extend sincere sympathy to the members of his family: to his
4 two sons, Mayor Richard Garcia and his wife, Peggy, and Bob Garcia
5 and his wife, Cris; to his daughter, Dahlia Guerra and her husband,
6 Arnulfo; to his eight grandchildren and one great-grandson; to his
7 four sisters, Elodia Lopez, Raquel Balderas and her husband,
8 Alfredo, Elizabeth Ramos and her husband, Ismael, and Esther
9 Garcia; and to his other relatives and friends; and, be it further
