1 WHEREAS, Sergeant Rosalind Perry of the Dallas Police
2 Department has been selected as a recipient of the Outstanding
3 Texan Award in the area of public safety/law enforcement by the
4 Texas Legislative Black Caucus; and

5 WHEREAS, Outstanding Texans are honored for the positive
6 impact they make in their communities, and Sergeant Perry's skills
7 and professionalism have benefited both her fellow citizens and the
8 department in which she serves; and

9 WHEREAS, A 16-year veteran of the Dallas police force,
10 Sergeant Perry brought to the department extensive experience as a
11 manager in the private sector; presently a member of the
12 communication division and assigned to the Patrol Bureau East
13 Division, she previously worked in the narcotics division,
14 abatement unit, and youth and family crimes division; and

15 WHEREAS, Before assuming her present duties in January 2005,
16 Sergeant Perry most recently served as legislative coordinator for
17 the department; her responsibilities in that post included
18 establishing communication links with the community and meeting
19 with area groups to discuss police services and sensitive issues
20 involving the community and the DPD; and

21 WHEREAS, Drawing on her professional experience and academic
22 training, Sergeant Perry has developed a highly acclaimed series of
23 workshops on police domestic violence, as well as an interactive
24 course on the causes of that violence; and

1 WHEREAS, This esteemed officer is licensed as a police
2 instructor by the Texas Commission on Law Enforcement Officer
3 Standards and Education; she holds a bachelor's degree from Rollins
4 College and currently attends Amberton University, where she is
5 pursuing a master's degree in counseling and professional
6 development; and

7 WHEREAS, Sergeant Rosalind Perry has had a profound effect on
8 the lives of countless residents of the Lone Star State, and it is a
9 great pleasure to honor her at this time; now, therefore, be it

10 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas
11 Legislature hereby commend Sergeant Rosalind Perry on being named a
12 recipient of the Outstanding Texan Award in the area of public
13 safety/law enforcement by the Texas Legislative Black Caucus and
