1 WHEREAS, Robert Medlock of Dallas has been selected as a
2 recipient of an Outstanding Texan Award in the area of professional
3 service by the Texas Legislative Black Caucus; and

4 WHEREAS, Outstanding Texans are honored for the positive
5 impact they make in their communities, and Mr. Medlock's remarkable
6 service as a substitute teacher with the Dallas Independent School
7 District has truly enhanced the lives of many individuals in the
8 Dallas area; and

9 WHEREAS, Retired from Ultra Instruments, this active
10 80-year-old is a graduate of Woodland High School and an honorably
11 discharged veteran of the U.S. Army Air Force; he earned an AB
12 degree from Samuel Huston College in Austin in 1950 before
13 beginning a 10-year career at the Lone Star School Book Depository;

16 substitute teacher, Mr. Medlock has demonstrated a commendable
17 desire to work with young people; in addition to performing his
18 regular teaching duties, Mr. Medlock devotes time to mentoring
19 at-risk students, many of whom have come to regard him as a
20 surrogate father; and

21 WHEREAS, Mr. Medlock is dedicated to improving his already
22 impressive pedagogical skills, whether studying on his own or
23 working with colleagues to advance his teaching technique; his
24 commitment to his students extends further through his perfect

1 attendance record; in fact, he has not missed a day of work during
2 his entire career; and

3 WHEREAS, A man of great faith, Mr. Medlock is a longtime
4 member of Allen Chapel Baptist Church; he is a devoted father and
5 grandfather, who has earned the respect and admiration of family,
6 friends, and colleagues through his exceptional and inspirational
7 service to his community; now, therefore, be it

8 RESOLVED, That the House of Representatives of the 79th Texas
9 Legislature hereby commend Robert Medlock on being named the
10 recipient of an Outstanding Texan Award by the Texas Legislative
