R E S O L U T I O N

2 Mathew Davis Puckett of Mason suffered an immeasurable loss with
3 the death of this brave soldier on September 13, 2004, at the age of
4 19; and

6 Iraq, Lance Corporal Puckett thought first of his family; he took
7 great pride in his work and was committed to fulfilling his mission
8 to the very best of his ability; courageous and steadfast, he earned
9 the Bronze Medal for valor and the Purple Heart; and

11 and women whose love of country leads them to military duty, and
12 time can never diminish the profound debt that Americans owe to
13 Lance Corporal Puckett for the service he undertook and the
