1 WHEREAS, For 50 years, *The Dallas Weekly* has provided a forum
2 for the African American community of North Texas; and

3 WHEREAS, Critically acclaimed and widely read, the newspaper
4 combines a commitment to excellence in journalism and thorough
5 coverage of issues pertaining and of interest to African Americans;
6 and

7 WHEREAS, In 1955, *The Dallas Weekly* was founded as a leaflet
8 titled *Circle News* by disc jockey and entrepreneur Tony Davis;
9 initially it was a vehicle to advertise African American businesses
10 in the city, but as it grew, the newspaper became an essential voice
11 for and by the African American community; and

12 WHEREAS, Now run by publisher Jim Washington and serving
13 Dallas, Fort Worth, Duncanville, Arlington, Irving, DeSoto, Grand
14 Prairie, Richardson, Plano, Garland, Cedar Hill, Mesquite, and
15 surrounding areas, *The Dallas Weekly* provides its readers with
16 passionate, well-rounded coverage of essential information, and it
17 has ably assumed an integral place among the news organizations of
18 the Lone Star State; now, therefore, be it
