- 1 WHEREAS, The House of Representatives of the State of Texas
- 2 joins the citizens of Corpus Christi in mourning the life of Travis
- 3 A. Peeler, a lawyer, lawmaker, and civic activist, who died March
- 4 19, 2005, at the age of 80; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Born in Christine on January 17, 1925, Mr. Peeler
- 6 served with the United States Army Air Corps in France during World
- 7 War II and flew more than 25 missions over Germany; and
- 8 WHEREAS, After the war, he attended Texas A&I University and
- 9 The University of Texas School of Law, from which he graduated
- second in his class in 1953; early in his career, Mr. Peeler worked
- 11 as a briefing attorney for the Texas Supreme Court and as a Corpus
- 12 Christi assistant city attorney; he later practiced law as a
- 13 partner in the firm of Prichard, Peeler, Cartwright, and Hall until
- 14 his retirement in 1998; and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Peeler was elected to the Texas House of
- 16 Representatives in 1960 and served four consecutive terms; during
- 17 his tenure in the legislature he introduced successful legislation
- 18 to abolish the poll tax and secured passage of a measure providing
- 19 for automatic voter registration renewal for those who vote
- 20 consistently; in a lighthearted vein, he added to a bill that was
- 21 assured of passage an amendment regarding punishment for Peeping
- 22 Toms, reducing the sentence from five years to two and a half years
- 23 if the perpetrator had only one eye; and
- WHEREAS, A lifelong student of politics, this distinguished

- 1 Texan taught political science at Del Mar College in the 1970s and
- 2 also served for two years as chairman of the Nueces County
- 3 Democratic Party; and
- WHEREAS, Travis Peeler was married to Jane Noe and later, for
- 5 25 years, to Louise E. Peeler, who preceded him in death; he was the
- 6 proud father of two children and two stepchildren; and
- WHEREAS, A man of courage, strength, and generosity, Travis
- 8 Peeler gave unselfishly of himself to others, and his wisdom,
- 9 warmth, and valued counsel will not be forgotten by those who had
- 10 the great fortune to know him; now, therefore, be it

- 12 Legislature hereby pay special tribute to the life of the Honorable
- 13 Travis A. Peeler and extend sincere sympathy to the members of his
