10 information technology and accounting in May 2005, Mr. Dovalina has  
11 previously received a National Science Foundation Hilltopper  
12 Mathematics and Computer Science Scholarship, an SEU Service

15 Department of the Treasury in Washington, D.C., through the  
16 Hispanic Association of Colleges and Universities and with the SEU  
17 Instructional Technology Department; a CANDAX-ME McNair Scholar,

20 participated in a cultural exchange program with the Universidad  
21 Autonoma Benito Juarez de Oaxaca; and

23 internships, this outstanding young Texan found time to engage in a  
24 number of extracurricular activities as an SEU undergraduate; he

1 served the Hispanic Student Association as a student ambassador,  
2 head ambassador, and special events coordinator and participated in

4 Community; moreover, he worked while attending SEU, finding  
5 employment with the IT Department as a lab assistant and an  
6 instructional computing designer and programmer; and

9 initiative and ability throughout his career at St. Edward's and  
10 his accomplishments have ensured him a future that is truly bright
