WHEREAS, Named in honor of the highly regarded radio and television personality Tavis Smiley, the new center is an 18,000-square-foot showcase of state-of-the-art broadcasting technology, including an announcer's studio, production studios, a satellite studio, a recording studio, a retail store, and a multipurpose classroom; and

WHEREAS, The establishment of the Tavis Smiley Center for Professional Media Studies and the Tavis Smiley School of Communications, which houses all TSU communications academic including journalism, speech communications, telecommunications, and electronic media, is part of an effort by the school to attract more minority students to the communications field; university officials approached Mr. Smiley, who holds the distinction of being the first person to host daily shows on both PBS and NPR, with a proposal to name the school's new media facilities after him; although the proposal no-strings-attached initiative intended to honor Mr. Smiley's contributions to the field and his stature as a role model for new generations of emerging journalists and media professionals, the
