

R E S O L U T I O N

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of
2 Texas, 79th Legislature, Regular Session, 2005, That House Rule 13,
3 Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13,
4 Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to
5 resolve the differences on House Bill 3485 (the establishment of
6 criminal law hearing officers in Cameron County), to consider and
7 take action on the following matter:

8 House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(2), is suspended to permit the
9 committee to omit text in added Section 54.1352, Government Code,
10 by striking proposed Subsection (c) of that section and relettering
11 the subsequent subsection of that section accordingly.

12 Explanation: The change is necessary to allow a criminal law
13 hearing officer appointed in Cameron County under Subchapter BB,
14 Chapter 54, Government Code, to engage in the private practice of
15 law and to serve as a mediator or arbitrator or otherwise
16 participate as a neutral party in an alternative dispute resolution
17 proceeding.
