13 WHEREAS, Jonathan attended Cooper High School in Abilene and
14 Southern Hills Church of Christ, and as a member of his church and
15 community he gave his time to help others of his home city by
16 volunteering at the Sears Methodist Nursing Home and the Sears
17 Methodist Retirement Center; he also participated in the Make a
18 Difference Trip as well as several other volunteer activities in
19 and around Abilene; and he currently works at radio station KBCY,
20 sharing a disc-jockey job; and

21 WHEREAS, While in attendance at the Texas School for the
22 Blind and Visually Impaired in Austin, Jonathan was an active
23 member in the community and still found the time to be a productive
24 student working toward his goal in the area of communications; he

1 was an independent student who has made remarkable progress toward
2 his career in communication and plans to continue his education in
3 that field; now, therefore, be it

5 congratulations to Jonathan Ardoyno for his graduation from the
