RESOLUTION

BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of 1 2 Texas, 79th Legislature, Regular Session, 2005, That House Rule 13, Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13, 3 Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to 4 resolve the differences on House Bill 1835 (the apportionment of 5 municipal infrastructure costs in regard to certain property 6 7 development projects) to consider and take action on the following 8 matter:

- 9 House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(1), is suspended to permit the 10 committee to change the text of SECTION 2 of the bill to read as 11 follows:
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to the approval of a development project that is not finally adjudicated before the effective date of this Act.
- Explanation: The change is necessary to ensure that the changes in law made by the bill apply to a matter that has not been finally determined by a court before the effective date of the Act.
