WHEREAS, At the district meet, Ms. Cabezas placed second in overall science and scored highest in chemistry, while Ms. Johnson placed third in overall science and Ms. Holloway made the top biology mark; the team won the wild card to move on as a group to regional competition, where Ms. Johnson placed first in overall science and scored highest in chemistry, and Ms. Holloway scored highest in physics; as a team, the students won first place and
