WHEREAS, He realized his dream of becoming a restaurateur in 16 1972, when he opened the doors of O'Melia's, a casual establishment 17 that became a favorite meeting place on the Upper East Side; over 18 the following decade the eatery served countless delighted patrons, 19 and the success Mr. O'Melia experienced allowed him to open a second 20 restaurant in New Jersey; and

21 WHEREAS, Later in life, this esteemed gentleman went on to 22 manage dining facilities and catering enterprises for some of New 23 Jersey's largest hotels, retiring from his distinguished career in 24 the 1990s; and
