R E S O L U T I O N

1 BE IT RESOLVED by the House of Representatives of the State of
2 Texas, 79th Legislature, Regular Session, 2005, That House Rule 13,
3 Section 9(a), be suspended in part as provided by House Rule 13,
4 Section 9(f), to enable the conference committee appointed to
5 resolve the differences on House Bill 1116 (the governmental
6 entities subject to the sunset review process) to consider and take
7 action on the following matter:

8 House Rule 13, Section 9(a)(4) is suspended to allow the
9 committee to add the following new language as Subsections (a) and
10 (b) of SECTION 1.04 of the conference committee report:

11 (a) Section 21.035(a), Education Code, is amended to read as
12 follows:

13 (a) ~~[The board is subject to Chapter 325, Government Code~~
14 ~~(Texas Sunset Act). Unless continued in existence as provided by~~
15 ~~that chapter, the board is abolished and this subchapter expires~~
16 ~~September 1, 2005.]~~

17 ~~[(b)]~~ The ~~[board and the]~~ Texas Education Agency shall
18 provide ~~[enter into a memorandum of understanding to consolidate]~~
19 administrative functions and services.

20 ~~[(c) The sunset commission shall focus its review of the~~
21 ~~board on the appropriateness of recommendations made by the sunset~~
22 ~~commission to the 78th Legislature and compliance with the MOU to~~
23 ~~consolidate functions.]~~

24 (b) Section 21.039, Education Code, is repealed.

1 Explanation: This addition is necessary to adjust the
2 language in the legislation regarding the administrative
3 relationship between the State Board for Educator Certification and
4 the Texas Education Agency.
