5 School before it was split into two smaller schools, the Class of
6 '65 was 751 members strong, and included among its achievements was
7 its contribution to the Garland Owls' back-to-back state football
8 championships in 1963 and 1964, which remains a point of pride for
9 the school even today; and

10 WHEREAS, The large size of the class and its geographic
11 dispersal over the years presented a daunting obstacle to a full
12 reunion, but spurred by the efforts of class member Steve Rhodes,
13 organizers succeeded in finding contact information for every class
14 member, and as a result the number of alumni, spouses, family
15 members, and teachers planning to attend far outstrips that of
16 similar events at other schools; and

18 gathering and a Saturday night barbecue and dance is ideal for
