1           WHEREAS, Parks and Wildlife Department game warden Anthony L.  
2 Norton of Athens has been named the 2005 Texas Boating Law  
3 Enforcement Officer of the Year; and

4           WHEREAS, Awarded by the National Association of State Boating  
5 Law Administrators, this prestigious honor recognizes dedicated  
6 men and women who have gone above and beyond their duties as marine  
7 patrol officers, and Officer Norton, who has served Region 3 in  
8 Henderson County with distinction for nearly eight years, is indeed  
9 one such deserving individual; and

10           WHEREAS, Officer Norton currently holds a Master Peace  
11 Officer license and is certified with the Commission on Law  
12 Enforcement Officer Standards and Education; an active boater,  
13 angler, and hunter education instructor, he has received extensive

24 number of worthy civic and professional organizations; currently

1 serving on the board of directors of the Athens Masonic Lodge, the  
2 Texas Game Warden Association, and the Texas Peace Officers  
3 Association, he is also active with the Henderson County Soccer  
4 Association, the Teenage Baseball League, and the Malakoff Football  
5 Association; and

6 WHEREAS, An immeasurable asset to his agency, Tony Norton is  
7 making important contributions to protecting the health and safety  
8 of residents and visitors to Henderson County, and he has earned the  
9 lasting respect of all who are privileged to work with him; now,
