- 1 WHEREAS, Luis Alvarez, a student at Anthony Middle School in
- 2 Anthony, Texas, has been named a national finalist in the 2004-2005
- 3 Do the Write Thing Challenge; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Sponsored by the National Campaign to Stop Violence,
- 5 the Do the Write Thing program encourages seventh-grade and
- 6 eighth-grade students to examine the impact of violence on their
- 7 lives and to make a personal commitment to do something about the
- 8 problem of violence; and

- 11 address three questions: how has violence affected that student's

- 16 Elizario--participated in the challenge; a total of 10 students, a
- boy and a girl from each school, were selected as school finalists,

- 19 national finalists; and

- 21 ceremony in Washington, D.C., and during their visit to the
- 22 nation's capital they have an opportunity to present their views on
- violence to a variety of government officials; in addition, their
- 24 writings are published in a book and placed in the Library of
