- 2 SECTION 3. Section 29.160(c), Education Code, is amended to 3 read as follows:
- 4 (c) A school district, regional education service center, 5 institution of higher education, local government, local workforce 6 development board, or community organization may develop three [one] or more coordination-of-resources demonstration projects 7 8 under which government-funded child-care services are operated in a 9 coordinated manner. An entity that develops a proposed demonstration project under this subsection must obtain approval of 10 the project from the state agency or agencies with regulatory 11 jurisdiction over the subject matter involved in the project. 12
