1-9 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-10 AN ACT

1-11 relating to certain special tuition rates at institutions of higher
1-12 education.

1-13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-14 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 54, Education Code, is
1-15 amended by adding Section 54.0514 to read as follows:

1-16 Sec. 54.0514. SPECIAL SUMMER TUITION RATES. The governing
1-17 board of an institution of higher education may charge an
1-18 undergraduate student enrolled for a summer term or session at the
1-19 institution an amount of tuition that is less than the amount of
1-20 tuition otherwise charged under Section 54.0513, but not less than
1-21 one-half of that amount.

1-22 SECTION 2. Section 54.072, Education Code, is amended to
1-23 read as follows:

1-24 Sec. 54.072. FLAT RATE TUITION AND FEES [~~PILOT PROJECT~~].

1-25 (a) In this section:

1-26 (1) "Flat rate tuition and fees" means tuition and
1-27 fees that are charged in the same total amount to each student
1-28 included in the group of students subject to the flat rate tuition
1-29 and fees.

1-30 (2) "Tuition and fees" [,"tuition"] means all academic
1-31 program costs related to enrollment in an academic course or degree
1-32 program that are charged to a student, including all charges
1-33 designated as tuition, mandatory fees, and incidental fees. The
1-34 term does not include voluntary fees.

1-35 (b) Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter,
1-36 the governing board of an institution of higher education [~~regents~~
1-37 ~~of The University of Texas System~~] may charge flat rate [~~establish a~~
1-38 ~~pilot project at The University of Texas at Austin involving not~~
1-39 ~~more than two colleges or degree programs designated by the board of~~
1-40 ~~regents under which the university charges the same amount of]~~
1-41 tuition and fees, in a different amount for each group, to each of
1-42 the following groups of [all undergraduate] students enrolled in a
1-43 college or degree program at the institution:

1-44 (1) all undergraduate resident students;

1-45 (2) all undergraduate nonresident students;

1-46 (3) all graduate resident students; and

1-47 (4) all graduate nonresident students [~~included in the~~
1-48 ~~pilot project~~].

1-49 (c) The board [~~of regents~~] may not require a full-time
1-50 student who pays flat rate tuition and fees under this section [~~the~~
1-51 ~~pilot project~~] to pay more tuition and fees than the average amount
1-52 of tuition and fees that a student [~~not included in the pilot~~
1-53 ~~project~~] would pay for enrolling in the institution [~~university for~~
1-54 ~~14 semester credit hours~~] for the same semester or term for:

1-55 (1) 14 semester credit hours if the student is an
1-56 undergraduate student; or

1-57 (2) nine semester credit hours if the student is a
1-58 graduate student.

1-59 [~~(d) The board of regents shall evaluate the effect of flat~~
1-60 ~~rate tuition charged under the pilot project on the number of~~
1-61 ~~semester credit hours taken by students included in the project~~
1-62 ~~each semester. The board shall report the results of the evaluation~~
1-63 ~~to the legislature not later than December 31, 2002, and December~~

2-1 ~~31, 2004.~~

2-2 [~~(c) This section expires September 1, 2005.~~]

2-3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
2-4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
2-5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
2-6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
2-7 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
2-8 legislative session.
