## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the establishment of certain programs and initiatives
3	designed to prevent the manufacture and use of methamphetamine.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 461, Health and Safety Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 461.019, to read as follows:
7	Sec. 461.019. PROGRAMS AND INITIATIVES TO PREVENT
8	MANUFACTURE AND USE OF METHAMPHETAMINE. (a) The Department of
9	State Health Services shall establish programs and initiatives to
10	prevent the manufacture and use of methamphetamine. The programs
11	and initiatives shall:
12	(1) educate retailers on the problem of methamphetamine
13	manufacturing and use in Texas;
14	(2) educate retailers on product management practices
15	that deter suspicious purchases and theft of products used to
16	<pre>manufacture methamphetamine;</pre>
17	(3) educate the public on the role the theft of
18	anhydrous ammonia plays in methamphetamine manufacturing;
19	(4) educate the public on equipment and practices that
20	deter theft; and
21	(5) educate the public on the dangers of
22	methamphetamine manufacturing and the increased hazards to
23	children exposed to chemicals and products inappropriately
24	diverted to manufacture methamphetamine.

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1	(b) The Department shall ensure its substance abuse efforts
2	<pre>concerning controlled substances address:</pre>
3	(1) student use and abuse of methamphetamine;
4	(2) how to identify methamphetamine use in students;
5	<u>and</u>
6	(3) how to identify student exposure to methamphetamine
7	manufacturing.
8	SECTION 2. This act takes effect September 1, 2005.
