1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the Indigent Health Care Advisory Committee.  
1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
1-12 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 61, Health and Safety  
1-13 Code, is amended by adding Section 61.012 to read as follows:  
1-14 Sec. 61.012. INDIGENT HEALTH CARE ADVISORY COMMITTEE. (a)  
1-15 The executive commissioner of the Health and Human Services  
1-16 Commission shall establish an advisory committee to advise the  
1-17 commission on rules and policies concerning indigent health care  
1-18 services.  
1-19 (b) The advisory committee shall consist of 11 members,  
1-20 including four consumers or persons representing consumers and  
1-21 seven other representatives, appointed by the executive  
1-22 commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission.  
1-23 (c) Chapter 2110, Government Code, does not apply to the  
1-24 size or composition of the advisory committee.  
1-25 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
