- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 843, Insurance Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 843.323 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 843.323. CONTRACT PROVISIONS PROHIBITING REJECTION OF
- 8 BATCHED CLAIMS. (a) If requested by a participating physician or
- 9 provider, a health maintenance organization shall include a
- 10 provision in the physician's or provider's contract providing that
- 11 the health maintenance organization or the health maintenance
- 12 organization's clearinghouse may not refuse to process or pay an
- 13 electronically submitted clean claim, as defined by Subchapter J,
- 14 because the claim is submitted together with or in a batch
- submission with a claim that is not a clean claim.
- 16 (b) In accordance with Chapters 82 and 84, the commissioner
- 17 may issue a cease and desist order against or impose sanctions on a
- 18 health maintenance organization that violates this section or a
- 19 contract provision adopted under this section.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 1301, Insurance Code, as
- 21 effective April 1, 2005, is amended by adding Section 1301.0641 to
- 22 read as follows:
- Sec. 1301.0641. CONTRACT PROVISIONS PROHIBITING REJECTION
- OF BATCHED CLAIMS. (a) If requested by a preferred provider, an

- 1 insurer shall include a provision in the preferred provider's
- 2 contract providing that the insurer or the insurer's clearinghouse
- 3 may not refuse to process or pay an electronically submitted clean
- 4 claim, as defined by Subchapter C, because the claim is submitted
- 5 together with or in a batch submission with a claim that is not a
- 6 clean claim.
- 7 (b) In accordance with Chapters 82 and 84, the commissioner
- 8 may issue a cease and desist order against or impose sanctions on an
- 9 insurer that violates this section or a contract provision adopted
- 10 under this section.
- 11 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 12 to a contract between an insurer and a preferred provider or a
- 13 health maintenance organization and a physician or provider that is
- 14 entered into or renewed on or after January 1, 2006. A contract
- 15 entered into before January 1, 2006, is governed by the law in
- 16 effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that
- 17 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
