## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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- 2 relating to eligibility for coverage of, and payment of premiums
- 3 for, certain individuals covered under certain group health benefit
- 4 plans.

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- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 1301, Insurance Code, as
- 7 effective April 1, 2005, is amended by adding Section 1301.0061 to
- 8 read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 1301.0061. TERMS OF ENROLLEE ELIGIBILITY. A contract
- 10 between an insurer and a group policyholder under a preferred
- 11 provider benefit plan must provide that:
- 12 (1) in addition to any other premiums for which the
- group policyholder is liable, the group policyholder is liable for
- 14 <u>an individual insured's premiums from the time the individual is no</u>
- 15 longer part of the group eligible for coverage under the policy
- 16 until the end of the month in which the policyholder notifies the
- insurer that the individual is no longer part of the group eligible
- 18 for coverage under the policy; and
- 19 (2) the individual remains covered under the policy
- 20 until the end of that period.
- 21 SECTION 2. Subchapter F, Chapter 843, Insurance Code, is
- 22 amended by adding Section 843.210 to read as follows:
- Sec. 843.210. TERMS OF ENROLLEE ELIGIBILITY. A contract
- 24 between a health maintenance organization and a group contract

- 1 holder must provide that:
- 2 (1) in addition to any other premiums for which the
- 3 group contract holder is liable, the group contract holder is
- 4 liable for an enrollee's premiums from the time the enrollee is no
- 5 longer part of the group eligible for coverage under the contract
- 6 until the end of the month in which the contract holder notifies the
- 7 health maintenance organization that the enrollee is no longer part
- 8 of the group eligible for coverage by the contract; and
- 9 (2) the enrollee remains covered by the contract until
- 10 the end of that period.
- 11 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- to a contract between an insurer or health maintenance organization
- 13 and a group policy or contract holder that is entered into or
- 14 renewed on or after January 1, 2006. A contract entered into or
- 15 renewed before January 1, 2006, is governed by the law in effect
- 16 immediately before the effective date of this Act, and that law is
- 17 continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
