4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 202, Property Code, is amended by adding
6	Section 202.008 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 202.008. REGULATION OF DISPLAY OF FLAG. (a) A
8	property owners' association may not enforce a restrictive covenant
9	that prohibits or restricts the display of the United States flag by
10	a property owner on the owner's property unless the prohibition or
11	restriction is clearly and specifically stated in the covenant.
12	(b) A restrictive covenant, rule, or other prohibition may
13	not be adopted if the prohibition or restriction prevents a
14	property owner from displaying the United States flag in a size not
15	larger than three feet by five feet in a respectful manner on the
16	owner's property.
17	(c) This section does not prohibit the adoption of a
18	restrictive covenant or rule:
19	(1) allowing the display of the United States flag
20	larger than three feet by five feet; or
21	(2) restricting the location of the display of the
22	United States flag on an owner's property or the size of a flagpole
23	that may be used for the display.
24	(d) For purposes of this section, the United States flag is

1 <u>displayed in a respectful manner if the flag is displayed in the</u> 2 <u>manner provided by 4 U.S.C. Sections 6-8.</u>

3 SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 202.008, Property Code, 4 as added by this Act, applies to a restrictive covenant, rule, or 5 other prohibition adopted before, on, or after the effective date 6 of this Act.

7 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
